# **SLADE - 2006 TECHNICAL RIDER**

The following requirements are to be considered the minimum to ensure a professional and powerful production of the show. The same requirements are to be considered an integral condition of the overall contract.

#### **PA SYSTEM**

An absolute minimum of 10Kw for small venues and theatres. For venues of over 1200 people the PA system has to be supplemented accordingly. If in any doubt please contact John Hessenthaler.

#### SPEAKER SYSTEM

The speaker system shall be of a professional standard e.g. EAW, Turbosound, JBL, Electrovoice.....etc.

#### FOH CONTROL

The FOH console needs a minimum of 32 inputs of which 20 inputs are from stage. Each input channel needs to have 4-way full parametric equalisation and an absolute minimum of six (6) independent auxiliary sends. Preferred consoles:- Midas, Yamaha desks or similar. No digital desks. Desk must be positioned in front of lead microphone and not more than a distance off 20 metres from the stage.

- 1 x Klark Teknik DN360 Dual 30 Band Graphic Equaliser
- 6 x Klark Teknik compressors (or Drawmer, BSS)
- 6 x Klark Teknik noise gates (or Drawmer, BSS)
- 2 x Yamaha SPX 990 (or Roland SRV330)
- 2 x Roland SDE 3000 (or Roland SDE 330 Delay or TC Electronics)
- 1 x CD Player
- 1 x Mini-Disc Player or CD Player for intro's etc.

#### STAGE MONITOR SYSTEM

The stage monitor system needs a minimum of four (4) sends from an on-stage console **never from FOH**. Three pairs of bi-amp wedges for the three front of stage microphone positions. A 3-way active drum-fill (this needs to be as powerful as possible). In addition side-fills are not a necessity except on larger stages.

#### STAGE LIGHTING RIG

A good quality basic lighting rig together with minimum One follow spot and operators willing to work as directed by the Artiste and/or their technicians.

#### DRUM-RISER


A carpet-topped drum riser must be supplied the minimum dimensions of such to be 8' in width, 8' in depth, and 18" in height.


#### **IMPORTANT**

The PA system should be supplied and rigged by two (2) competent engineers who have a complete working knowledge of the rig. We do not supply our own monitor engineer. Our FOH engineer does not engineer for support bands unless previously agreed in advance and in writing. Finally, any situation that may arise whereby an in-house PA system has to be supplemented...do not agree any conditions with either the venue or the promoter without first consulting our management to discuss a possible compromise.

When the equipment is supplied for a 'Tour' situation. Particular attention to detail of our specifications is of the utmost importance. The same equipment shall be used for all tour dates. Any exchange of equipment mid-tour must first be approved by our FOH engineer.
